Vestcor's Breaking New Ground with Florida I

Vestcor Communities was awarded the contract by Florida Polytechnic University to build its first student residence hall. Located in Lakeland, Florida Polytechnic is the newest member of the Florida State University System specializing in STEM programs, specifically technology and engineering, in an applied learning environment.

The residence hall will have 219 bedrooms, most in four bedrooms/two bath units with a kitchenette. The spacious floor plans come fully furnished including a 42" Smart TV. The residence hall will have amenities designed to meet students' needs academically and socially, including an ultra modern community center, study lounge with conference room, computer center with printers, snack lounge and much more.

The structure of this public private partnership is a paradigm shift from the traditional on campus housing

between a private developer and public University. While we work as partners, the community is being built with all private money and there is not a master lease from the university.

Our experience in providing off-campus student housing gives us a unique perspective for the development of this on-campus residence hall. We have incorporated certain amenities that have proven valuable in off-campus housing, including washer and dryers in each unit, resident lounges and an active resident life program.

Construction is well under-way and will be complete for the inaugural class in August 2014. Summit Contractors began construction in mid December and the project is rapidly progressing with the completion of the roof in April.
